

Benson S. Hsu, MD, MBA, FAAP, FCCM

Dr. Benson Hsu is a Professor of Pediatrics and a board-certified pediatric critical care physician at the University of South Dakota Sanford School of Medicine in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

Dr. Hsu serves as a Senior Advisor for McKinsey & Company, having previously held positions on the corporate leadership team overseeing data, analytics, and population health at Sanford Health, a \$6+ billion rural healthcare system. He has co-founded two nonprofits addressing health equity, serving as the Chief Scientific Officer of the Preparedness and Treatment Equality Coalition (PTEC) and President of Aequitas Health. PTEC has awarded almost half a million in funding directed at the intersection of payment, data, and inequities. Aequitas Health, a new medical honor society, has over 20% of all MD-granting medical schools starting chapters. An NIH-funded researcher and the Chair of the Section on Critical Care (SOCC) at the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), Dr. Hsu has published over 70 peer-reviewed publications and abstracts, including eight national practice guidelines for pediatric care, in journals such as the *New England Journal of Medicine Catalyst*, *Pediatric Critical Care Medicine*, and *Harvard Business Review*.

Dr. Hsu received his AB in Economics from Princeton University and his MBA from Duke University Fuqua School of Business, graduating as a Fuqua Scholar. He earned his MD from the University of Missouri School of Medicine with training in Pediatrics and Pediatric Critical Care Medicine at the University of Wisconsin. Dr. Hsu is a member of Alpha Omega Alpha (AOA), an Aspen Institute Health Innovators Fellow, and a member of the Aspen Global Leadership Network.
